

Level 2 – For those wanting to build on the foundations that they have taught and specifically working on building up the distance handling aspect. Build your customers up to Elite competition level standard.

You must pass the Canine Hoopers UK Level 1 assessment to attend the Level 2 course.

You must pass the Canine HoopersUK Level 2 Instructors Exam to become a Level 2 Accredited Instructor.

The Level 2 assessment will include 3 exercises chosen at random from the Level 1 assessment.

When instructing your class you are required to rely upon modern, fun, positive re-enforcement training techniques. Anyone using aversive methods or non-ethical methods will be immediately dismissed from the assessment.

You will be asked questions on Canine Hoopers UK rules.

To pass the assessment you must demonstrate your ability to instruct a class in the following exercises:

- Increasing the distance between the obstacles
- Increasing the distance between the handler and the obstacles
- Forward focus – driving the dog on
- Verbal cues
- Body cues
- Side changes at a distance
- Distance course choices
- Turn aways out of tunnels/off obstacles at a distance

Please remember that it is not the dogs that are under assessment but you as the instructor 😊

You will need to bring a dog with you to the training course
