NFC runs available

A handler may choose to run NFC in any class in which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scime upon entering the ring before commencing their run. The handler then has the standard course time to train in the ring.

A silent toy may be used when running NFC. Alternatively a licky bottle treat, a solid lick stick or a solid chew of some sort may be used, E.g. pigs ears, stag bars, bull bars, horns etc. Training Treats/small individual treats may NOT be taken into the ring. Chews that crumble may NOT be taken into the ring.

1. Hoopers – Starters
2. Hoopers - Veteran
3. Barrellers – Starters
4. Barrellers - Veteran
5. Tunnellers – Starters
6. Tunnellers - Veteran

Class Descriptions

Hoopers – A course made purely of Hoops.

Barrellers – A course consisting of Hoops, Barrels and possibly Tunnels.

Tunnellers – A course consisting of mostly tunnels but will use some hoops and/or barrels.

Dog Height/s

Small – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15cm or less

Large – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15.1cm or more

Level Classification

Starters – All NEW dogs start here.

Beginners

Novice

Masters

Elite

Veteran – Available for dogs over the age of 10yrs.

Progression

Each of the class types will have a separate progression system. Thereby allowing a dog to become a Masters in Hoopers without ever having to compete in a class containing contacts.

Points earned in one type of class will only count towards progression of that class type, eg Points earned in Hoopers classes won't count towards progression in Barrellers.

Awards

Placement rosettes will be awarded to 20% of pre-entered numbers.

Trophies/Prizes will be awarded based on pre-entered class numbers.

Trophies/Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- ✓ 5 or less dogs in class – no prize/trophy
- ✓ Less than 20 dogs in class – 1st
- ✓ 21 to 40 dogs in class – 2nd
- ✓ 41 to 60 dogs in class – 3rd
- ✓ 61 to 80 dogs in class – 4th
- ✓ 81 to 100 dogs in class – 5th
