Dogs & Handlers must have valid Canine Hoopers UK membership numbers at the time of entering and competing, this must be submitted at the time of entry.

Entry Fees: £3.50 Standard classes, Finals entry £6 per dog. Ring cards will be collected at the show.

Pay on the day entries available if not fully subscribed £4 per class. You must have both your handler and dog registration numbers to enter on the day.

NFC runs are available in standard classes. A handler may choose to run NFC in any class in which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scime upon entering the ring before commencing their run. The handler then has the standard course time to train in the ring.

### Class Descriptions

Hoopers – A course made purely of Hoops.

Barrellers – A course consisting of Hoops, Barrels and Tunnels.

Tunnellers – A course consisting of mostly tunnels but will use some hoops and/or barrels.

Touch N Go – A course containing a TanGo mat in addition to hoops, barrels and/or tunnels.

Finals classes may use any standard equipment under Canine Hoopers UK rules.

### Dog Section

Small – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15cm or less

Large – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15.1cm or more

Veteran – Large or small dogs aged 7yrs or over

### Level Classification

Starters – All NEW dogs start here. Beginners Novice Masters, Elite

Progression Each of the class types will have a separate progression system. Points earned in one type of class will only count towards progression of that class type, eg Points earned in Hoopers classes won't count towards progression in Barrellers.

### Awards

Placement rosettes will be awarded to 20% of pre-entered numbers in standard progression classes. Q rosettes will be available for all unplaced, qualifying runs. Prizes or trophies may be awarded based on pre-entered class numbers. Prizes (such as trophies or medals) will be awarded as follows:

5 or less dogs in class – no prize,

Less than 20 dogs in class – 1<sup>st</sup>

21 to 40 dogs in class – 2<sup>nd</sup>

41 to 60 dogs in class – 3<sup>rd</sup>

61 to 80 dogs in class – 4<sup>th</sup>

81 to 100 dogs in class – 5<sup>th</sup>

## **Finals Eligibility Entry & Awards.**

Any registered dog and handler partnership who have gained 3 or more Qualifying runs under Canine Hoopers UK rules at Canine Hoopers UK licensed shows since 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 are eligible to enter the National Finals 2019. Qualifying runs can be earned from any standard progression class type at Starters level in either Small, Large or Veteran.

There is a single entry fee of £6 for entry into the National Finals. Subject to entry levels it may be necessary to hold heats, in which case there will be no further charge should any extra runs be made available.

Rosettes will be to a minimum of 20% and Trophies to a minimum of 3<sup>rd</sup> in each section.

Finals must be entered prior to the closing date 1<sup>st</sup> August 2019. Subject to numbers, it may be possible to accept late entries from competitors who had not gained 3 Qualifying runs prior to the closing date, but have since achieved qualifying eligibility. Entries will not be accepted in this manner for those who were previously eligible but missed the closing date.

Standard Canine Hoopers UK rules, marking and scoring apply during the finals classes. Progression points are not available.
