You will be able to walk the course (without your dog) 15 minutes before judging starts for each class. Large, Small and Veteran all run together but the results are separate. It is your responsibility to be available for your class. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible.

Competitors with bitches in season must advise the show licensee (before the day of the show) so that they can be moved to the back of the running order as per Canine Hoopers UK Rules and Regulations.

Class Descriptions:

Hoopers – A course only consisting of hoops

Barrellers – A course consisting of hoops, barrels and possibly tunnels

Tunnellers – A course consisting of mostly tunnels but will also contain hoops and/or barrels

Touch N Go – A course consisting of a Touch N Go mat, tunnels, barrels and hoops.

Level Classification:

Starters – All NEW dogs start here.

Veteran – As per current CHUK Rules.

Dog Heights:

Dogs who have not previously attended a Canine Hoopers UK show may need to be measured. Measuring will be available at the show. Please indicate on your entry form if your dog needs measuring before judging of the first class starts.

Small – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15cm or less

Large – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15.1cm or more.

NFC Runs:

NFC runs are available and a handler may choose to run NFC in any class for which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scribe upon entering the ring and before commencing their run. The handler will then have the standard course time to train in the ring.

Toys and Treats:

A silent toy may be held when running in Starters classes. The dog must not touch the toy. NFC handlers may use a licky bottle treat, a solid lick stick or a solid chew of some sort, E.g. pigs ears, stag bars, bull bars, horns etc. Training Treats/small individual treats may NOT be taken into the ring or carried in a treat bag on the handler's person. Chews that crumble or squeeze tube treats may NOT be taken into the ring.

Additional Information:

Pay on the Day Entries are accepted if capped numbers have not been reached. Pay on the Day Entries are £15 for all 4 runs. You must be CHUK registered and bring your (and your dog's) CHUK numbers with you in order to enter on the day.

Catering:

There will be catering vans on site, selling a selection of hot and cold food and drinks. Ring party will receive free refreshments throughout the day.

Prizes and Eligibility for Progression:

Placement rosettes are awarded to 20% of pre-entered numbers, or 3rd place, whichever number is greater. Clear round rosettes will be awarded for all unplaced clears.

Trophies will be awarded to 1st place in each class or to 2nd place for classes with more than 20 pre-entries, and 3rd place for classes with more than 40 pre-entries.

Only points gained in progression classes, as specified in the current Canine Hoopers UK Rules & Regulations, count towards a dog's progression to their next level.

Points will be awarded by the judge in the progression classes only. If a dog acquires sufficient points to move to the next level during a show, they may continue at the lower level until the next Canine Hoopers UK progression date.

Only points gained in progression classes at Canine Hoopers UK licenced shows may be used for progression through the levels in that class. (A dog may be eligible to run at one level in each class type).

The Canine Hoopers UK Rules and Regulations list the points required to progress through the levels in each class.

Welfare of Dogs:

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Canine Hoopers UK licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Canine Hoopers UK Committee for disciplinary action under Canine Hoopers UK Rules and Regulations.

Remember to always pick up after your dog(s).

All dogs MUST be kept on lead outside the competing arenas AT ALL TIMES. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Hoopers show licensed by Canine Hoopers UK. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show. Space must be allowed for nervous and/or 'yellow coat/lead' dogs. Competitors are required to move out of the path of a space required dog when 'Space Dog' is called.

PLEASE ADHERE TO POSTED ON-SITE SPEED LIMITS AND PARK AS DIRECTED.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Show Photography:

A photographer may be present at this show. By participating in this event you understand that images may be used for promotional purposes including but not limited to printed publications, social media and online resources.

Cancellation:

In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, Kelluki Agility will refund fees less reasonably incurred expenses. Refunds will be processed in the manner in which a competitor entered the show and will be issued within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.

Agility Show:

This show is to be held as part of a KC Open Agility Show at the same venue and it is therefore required that any dogs entered for the Hoopers show must be registered with the Kennel Club and they must be entered NFC for the agility competition. This will be done automatically for all dogs pre-entered for this show, but details of any dogs entering on the day must be handed to the show secretary on the morning of the show, unless they are already entered for the agility competition.

There is an exercise area available at the show. Please keep your dogs under strict control and be respectful to other users of the venue. You must ensure that your dogs are always contained within the parameters of the show and they must not stray onto any land deemed to be out of bounds to exhibitors. Anybody found trespassing on neighbouring fields will be asked to leave the show.

GDPR:

For the purposes of show processing and scoring at the event, your details will be entered into a computer system and stored in accordance with GDPR. Show results will be published online at www.agilityplaza.com.

How to find us!

On A31 heading towards Alton / Farnham

At the roundabout for Bordon and Alton, take the 1st exit signposted (Bordon & Alton) and Binsted, Holybourne and Treloar College) onto Montecchio Way/B3004

Continue to the lights (approx. 0.3 miles)

Turn right at the traffic lights onto London Rd and stay on the road for 1.5 miles. You will pass through Holybourne, under 2 bridges and over 1 bridge, continue on the road past Hawbridge Farm on the right to the crossroads.

Turn right onto Clay's Lane. Destination will be on the right about 0.2 miles up Clay's Lane.

Heading Towards Winchester/Alton

Head on the A31 towards Alton, at the 1st roundabout take the 2nd exit towards Borden and Alton onto Montecchio Way/B3004 and follow as per above instructions.

IMPORTANT: Your SATNAV may direct you on a route avoiding Holybourne and turning off the A31 to a side road. This route will take you to venue but due to limited passing
