Prizes/Rosettes awarded:

Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1st-3rd place in each class, with additional places up to 20% of entry numbers.

Trophies will be presented to 1st place in each class.

Q rosettes will be presented for all qualifying rounds, as specified in Canine Hoopers UK Rules & Regulations.

Classes

1. Hoopers Starters & Veteran A course made purely of Hoops
2. Tunnellers Starters & A course consisting of mostly tunnels but will use
Veteran some hoops and/or barrels
3. Barrellers Starters & Veteran A course consisting of Hoops, Barrels and possibly
Tunnels
4. Touch n Go Starters & Veteran A course consisting of Hoops, Barrels, Tunnels and
1 touch n go mat

NFC runs available: A handler may choose to run NFC in any class in which they are eligible to compete.

The handler must inform the scribe upon entering the ring before commencing their run. The handler then has the standard course time to train in the ring. A lick bottle treat, a solid lick stick or a solid chew of some sort may be used, E.g. pigs' ears, stag bars, bull bars, horns etc. Training Treats/small individual treats may NOT be taken into the ring. Chews that crumble may NOT be taken into the ring.

A silent toy may be used when running BUT must not leave the hand or be touched by the dog until the last hoop/obstacle has been crossed.

Dog Height/s

Small – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15cm or less: Large – Dogs 15.1cm or more. Measuring can be done on the day if needed.

Level Classification

Starters – All NEW dogs start here.

Veteran – Available for dogs over the age of 7yrs.

Catering

This may be available on the day, however at this time not guaranteed.

SHOW PHOTOGRAPHY

A photographer may be present at this show. By participating in this event, you understand that images may be used for promotional purposes including but not limited to printed publications, social media and online resources.

WELFARE OF DOGS AT THE SHOW

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Canine Hoopers UK licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Canine Hoopers UK Committee for disciplinary action under Canine Hoopers UK Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Hoopers show licensed by Canine Hoopers UK. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.

Space must be allowed for nervous and/or 'yellow coat/lead' dogs. Competitors are required to move out of the path of a space required dog when 'Space Dog' is called .

Dogs must be healthy and fit to run at any CHUK show, and must not have come into contact with any dogs with a contagious disease in the 21 days prior to the show

CANCELLATION

If the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances Active Agility (Active Dog Services) will refund fees less reasonably incurred expenses. Refunds will be processed in the way a competitor entered the show and will be issued within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.

Exercise Area:

The grass area opposite the small arena at the top of the car park will be available to exercise your dogs. Please may we ask that dogs are kept on leads when exercising in this area. Bins will be provided to dispose of dog waste please use them.

Warm up Area:

A small number of hoops will be made available in the warmup area, this is the arena at the top of the car park. Please do not use any of the other equipment in this area. Please be courteous to other users and once you have finished warming up leave the arena.

Please note 5mph throughout the site even if you are late.
