You will be able to walk courses without your dog 10 mins before judging starts for each class

Large, Small and Veterans will run together but results are separate

There will not be running orders. It is your responsibility to make sure you are available to walk the course and run each class. If your dog requires space these dogs will run at the end of a class when the arena is quiet the same applies for bitches in season.

Handlers may choose to run NFC in any class in which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scribe on entering the ring the handler then has the standard course time to train in the ring, only silent toys may be used.

CLASS DEFINITION

Hoopers	A course only consisting of hoops
Barellers	A course consisting of hoops barrels and possibly tunnels
Tunnellers	A course consisting of mostly tunnels but may also contain hoops and /or barrels
Touch n go	A course consisting of a touch and go mat, tunnels ,barrels and hoops

AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded 20% of per paid entries (Large, Small and Veterans)

Trophies will be awarded see CHUK rules (Large, Small and Veterans)

Q rosettes will also be available for clear rounds

WELFARE OF DOGS AT THE SHOW

A competitor whose dog is entered at a CHUK licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs for their dogs are met and should not knowingly put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the CHUK committee for disciplinary action under CHUK rules and regulations

Space must be allowed for nervous/yellow coat/yellow lead dogs, competitors are required to move out of the path of a space required dog when YELLOW DOG is called

Dogs must be healthy and fit to run at any CHUK show and must not have come into contact with any dog with a contagious disease in the 21 days prior to the show

CANCELLATION OF SHOW

In the event the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances G-WHIZZ HOOPERS will refund fees less reasonably incurred expenses. Refunds will be processed in the manner in which a competitor entered the show and will be issued within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.

CATERING

Tea, coffee, cake and biscuits will be available at the show

PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN LUNCH

There are shops and takeaways in Milnthorpe a few miles away. Turn right out of venue keep going you will come to Milnthorpe

Asda as you go into Kendal. Turn left out of the venue at the end of the road turn left keep going until you see hospital Asda is 200mts further on

DIRECTION TO SHOW

From north exit at junction 36 M6 take 1st exit off roundabout *at next roundabout take 1st exit carry on this road for 1 mile (passing petrol station on your right) at the

Crooklands hotel turn left over the canal bridge the venue is 500 yard on your right can be seen from the road

From the south exit at junction 36 M6 take the 3rd exit off roundabout then follow direction from *for north
