SUPER HOOPERS TOURNAMENT:

The Super Hoopers Tournament is open to teams of 4 handlers and dogs. Team dogs can be different sizes. If you aren't already part of a team, and would like to be, we can help you link up (via Facebook) with other handlers to form a team. Each team member runs in the 8 progression classes. Their top 3 results from those classes will be combined to contribute to their team's results towards the weekend Team Championship.

The team can choose to run in the Mixed Team Relay, which is a special class. The results of the relay do not count towards the Team Championship.

CAMPING:

Camping is available – Friday 21st August to Sunday 23rd August, booking for camping is on your CHUK Entry Form.

No arrival on site until 3pm on the Friday. All competitors must leave on Sunday. **Camping is £20 per pitch for the event.**

SATURDAY - HOOPERS WORKSHOPS:

There are two workshops running from 9a.m. to 12p.m. See separate booking form.

Each workshop is **£35 per handler/dog team**. 8 dog places per workshop.

Workshop 1: Sequences / Confidence Building / Pre Competition Experience with Emma Hendy Adv.ACHUKI

Workshop 2: Course Running / Distance Building with Carol Bentley Adv.ACHUKI

PROGRESSION CLASSES:

There are 8 Progression classes, spread over the two days, as listed below.

Results from the progression classes contribute to a team's tournament results. The top 3 results from the 8 progression classes for each team member will be combined and added together to find the Team Tournament Champions (the Team Relay class results do not contribute to the team's results for the Championship).

Hoopers – A course made purely of Hoops.

Barrellers – A course consisting of Hoops, Barrels and possibly Tunnels.

Tunnellers – A course consisting of mostly tunnels but will use some hoops and/or barrels.

Touch N Go - A course that can include Hoops, Barrels, Tunnels and 1 TanGo Mat.

You will be allowed to walk the courses, without your dog(s), ½ hour before judging for the classes begin.

It is your responsibility to be available for your class and running order.

SATURDAY - PROGRESSION CLASSES:

Open to all CHUK registered dogs. Normal progressions points for all entrants as per CHUK rules.

Saturday progression classes open at 12p.m. Briefing/course walking at 12.30p.m. Judging starts at 1p.m.

SUNDAY MIXED TEAM RELAY CLASS:

Special Class No: 25

This class is covered by the weekend cost but is not obligatory, it is your choice to run your Tournament Team.

The course may include Hoops, Barrels, Tunnels & Touch N Go Mat.

As this is a Special Class, no progression points are gained & results do not contribute to the Tournament Championship.

SUNDAY PROGRESSION CLASSES:

Open to all CHUK registered dogs. Normal progressions points for all entrants as per CHUK rules.

DOG HEIGHT/S:

Dogs who have not previously attended a Canine Hoopers UK Show may need to be measured. Measuring will be available - please indicate on your entry form if your dog needs measuring before judging of the first class starts.

Small – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15cm or less

Large – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15.1cm or more

LEVEL CLASSIFICATION:

Starters – All NEW dogs start here.

Veteran – As per current CHUK rules.

NFC RUNS:

NFC runs are available in normal progression classes. A handler may choose to run NFC in any class in which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scribe upon entering the ring before commencing their run. The handler then has the standard course time to train in the ring.

PRIZES AND ELIGIBILITY FOR PROGRESSION POINTS:

Placement rosettes are awarded to 20% of pre-entered numbers. Q rosettes are presented for all unplaced, qualifying runs. In addition progression class trophies are awarded as shown below, based on pre-entered class numbers.

- 5 or less dogs in class – no Trophy
- 6-20 dogs in class – 1st Place Trophy
- 21 to 40 dogs in class – 1st & 2nd Place Trophies
- Team Championship Trophies will be awarded.

Only points gained in progression classes, as specified in the current Canine Hoopers UK Rules & Regulations, count towards a dog's progression to their next Level.

TOYS/TREATS:

A silent toy may be held when running in Starters classes. The dog must not touch the toy. NFC handlers may use a licky bottle treat, a solid lick stick or a solid chew of some sort, E.g. pigs ears, stag bars, bull bars, horns etc. Training Treats/small individual treats may NOT be taken into the ring or carried in a treat bag on the handler's person. Chews that crumble or squeeze tube treats may NOT be taken into the ring.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

There is on-site catering during the day only. No evening catering.

CANCELLATIONS:

In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, Super Hoopers will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. Refunds will be processed in the manner in which a competitor entered the show. Super Hoopers will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.

WELFARE OF DOGS:

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Canine Hoopers UK licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Canine Hoopers UK Committee for disciplinary action under Canine Hoopers UK Rules and Regulations.

Remember ALWAYS pick up after your dog(s). Dogs MUST be kept on lead outside competing arenas AT ALL TIMES.

The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Hoopers show licensed by Canine Hoopers UK. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.

Space must be allowed for nervous and/or 'yellow coat/lead' dogs, we call these Cosmic Dogs. Competitors are required to move out of the path of a space required dog when '**COSMIC Dog**' is called .

PLEASE ADHERE TO POSTED ON-SITE SPEED LIMITS - NO EXCEPTIONS
