



CHUK Licensed Progression Event

These events will be licensed and only allowed to take place during the period of disruption caused by the current outbreak of Coronavirus. They will cease once the all-clear has been given for normal show gatherings to take place.

All events must follow Canine Hoopers UK Rules & Regulations and these additional Covid-19 guidelines.

- Organisers must check and confirm that their insurance is valid for the event.
- Courses are set by an ACHUKI or an Adv.ACHUKI. It is suggested that designing courses that can be safely reversed would be advisable.
- Course runs will be judged and timed as normal.
- Points will be accepted towards the handler & dog team's progression through the CHUK competition levels.
- Hosts may opt to run Progression events for Qualifying Rosettes and Points only.
- The number of competitors and dog(s) on site must comply with the current Government guidelines regarding the number of people allowed to congregate.
- Hand sanitisers must be available. Competitors should be asked to bring their own, as well as the host providing, hand sanitisers.
- Hand washing facilities should be available if possible.
- Competitors should be advised to bring disposable gloves.
- Current Social Distancing Rules must be adhered to at all times and any competitor breaching these, except in an emergency, may be disqualified from events without any refund.
- Entries must be booked to a specific time-slot, allowing time for toilet and rest breaks between runs where more than 1 course is set up, and for competitors to depart before the next person/group arrives.
