Dogs & Handlers must have valid Canine Hoopers UK membership numbers at the time of entering and competing, this must be submitted at the time of entry.

Pay on the day entries available if not fully subscribed £4 per class. You must have both your handler and dog registration numbers to enter on the day.

NFC runs are available in standard classes. A handler may choose to run NFC in any class in which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scime upon entering the ring before commencing their run. The handler then has the standard course time to train in the ring.

Class Descriptions

Hoopers – A course made purely of Hoops.

Barrellers – A course consisting of Hoops, Barrels and Tunnels.

Tunnellers – A course consisting of mostly tunnels but will use some hoops and/or barrels.

Touch N Go – A course containing a TanGo mat in addition to hoops, barrels and/or tunnels.

Finals classes may use any standard equipment under Canine Hoopers UK rules.

Dog Section

Small – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 13cm or less

Medium – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 13.1cm up to 17cm

Large – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 17.1cm or more

Veteran – Dogs aged 7yrs or over who are no longer

Awards

Placement rosettes will be awarded to 20% of pre-entered numbers in standard progression classes. Q rosettes will be available for all unplaced, qualifying runs. Prizes or trophies may be awarded based on pre-entered class numbers. Prizes (such as trophies or medals) will be awarded as follows:

5 or less dogs in class – no prize,

41 to 60 dogs in class – 3rd

Less than 20 dogs in class – 1st

61 to 80 dogs in class – 4th

21 to 40 dogs in class – 2nd

81 to 100 dogs in class – 5th

Finals Eligibility Entry & Awards.

Any registered dog and handler partnership who have gained 3 or more Qualifying runs under Canine Hoopers UK rules at Canine Hoopers UK licensed shows between 24th August 2020 and 19th August 2021 are eligible to enter the National Finals 2021. Qualifying runs can be earned from any standard progression class type in either Small, Medium, Large or Veteran.

There is a single entry fee of £8 for entry into the National Finals.

Rosettes will be to a minimum of 20% and Trophies to a minimum of 3rd in each section.

Finals must be entered prior to the closing date 1st August 2021. Subject to numbers, it may be possible to accept late entries from competitors who had not gained 3 Qualifying runs prior to the closing date, but have since achieved qualifying eligibility. In this instance please email entries@caninehoopersuk.co.uk with your dogs membership number and date of all qualifying runs. Entries will not be accepted in this manner for those who were previously eligible but missed the closing date.

Standard Canine Hoopers UK rules, marking and scoring apply during the finals classes. Progression points are not available.

Event Info

Measuring

All dogs competing in either the Small or Medium sections must be measured prior to competing with Canine Hoopers UK. Measuring will be available at this event, simply email entries@caninehoopersuk.co.uk with details of dogs who will need measuring. Dogs must be a minimum of 15 months of age to be measured.

T-Shirts

ALL competitors running in the National Finals are required to wear a 2021 National Finals CHUK T-shirt. Whenever you are in the ring to walk or run a dog, you MUST be wearing your 2021 t-shirt. Entry to the ring without your 2021 t-shirt will not be permitted.
