Additional Information:

Please note that there is a cap of **70** dogs for this show. Pay on the Day Entries accepted provided the pre-paid entries have not reached cap levels prior to the entry closing date.

Prizes/Rosettes awarded:

Every clear round will be awarded a Q rosette.

Placings/ prizes will be based on pre-entered class numbers and awarded in line with CHUK rules.

Classes:

1. Tunnellers (all levels) – a course consisting of tunnels, barrels and hoops
2. Hoopers (all levels) - a course made of purely hoops
3. Barrellers (all levels) – a course consisting of barrels, hoops and tunnels
4. Touch N Go(all levels) – A course consisting of Tango Mat plus a combination of hoops, barrels and tunnels

NFC Runs available

A handler may choose to run NFC in any class in which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scribe on entering the ring before commencing their run. The handler then has the standard course time to train in the ring. A licky treat bottle, a solid lick stick or a solid chew of some sort may be used (e.g. pigs ears, stag bars, horns etc) – training treats / small individual treats MAY NOT be taken in the ring nor chews that crumble.

A silent toy may be used when running at **STARTERS LEVEL only** BUT must not leave the hand or be touched by the dog until the last hoop/obstacle has been crossed.

Dog Height/s

Small – dogs with an ulna measurement of 130mm or less

Medium – dogs with an ulna measurement of 130.5mm to 170mm

Large – dogs with an ulna measurement of 170.5mm or more

Unless your dog is obviously large they will need to be measured (they only need to be measured once unless they are under 2 years, so if they have been previously measured you do not need to ask for a further measure at this show)

Level Classification

Starters – ALL new dogs start here

Novice – for dogs who have achieved the required number of qualifying points to progress out of Starters

Veteran – Available for dogs aged 7 or over who have been registered with CHUK as Veteran

WELFARE OF DOGS AT THE EVENT

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Canine Hoopers UK licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Canine Hoopers UK Committee for disciplinary action under Canine Hoopers UK Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars is not permitted at any Hoopers show licensed by Canine Hoopers UK. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.

Space must be allowed for nervous and/or 'yellow coat/ lead' dogs. Competitors are required to move out of the space required when 'Space Dog' is called.

Dogs must be healthy and fit to run at any CHUK show, and must not have come into contact with any dogs with a contagious disease within 21 days prior to the show.

CANCELLATION

In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances Top Farm Hoopers will refund fees less reasonably incurred expenses. Refunds will be processed in the manner in which a competitor entered the show and will be issued within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.
